EUROPEAN EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT. HOW DO THE UKRAINIAN STUDENTS SEE IT?

- First, is the insufficient educational provision for different practical classes;
- Low development of training and production integration;
- Weak scientific and applied principles for professional training;
- Low level of professional English of students.

Studying in other country or city is a unique experience that allows us to enrich ourselves both personally and professionally. For students, European educational space is a form of secondary socialization of the individual. Participation in academic mobility is one way of learning that expands the horizons of the individual and stimulates intellectual maneuverability. It is also a tool of personal development. Such trips contribute to the emergence of young people with a broad outlook and a high intellectual level, who are ready for international communication.
