

Requirements regarding material presentation

1. Abstract. The length of the abstract should be one *full-page* A4 – size printed in Word for Windows (2003 or lower) in one of the conference languages. The abstract should be submitted together with an application form. The abstract must be sent by e-mail, printed, signed by the authors and sent by the letter.

2. Report (Paper). The report must be prepared in Ukrainian language and printed on one side of A4 size. Margins: left margin – 3cm, right margin – 1.5cm, top and bottom margins – 2cm. (All pages must be numbered).

Volume of publication – not less than 3 and not more than 5 pages. The reports must be sent by e-mail and printed, signed by the authors and sent by the letter.

The report is supplied with: 1) experts' certificate of the report; participants from CIS countries must inform about the possibility of open publication of the report(2 copies); 2) separate document – abstracts in three languages (Ukrainian, Russian, English), up to 10 lines, including the title of the article, names of the authors, bibliography, annotation and key words.

Arrangement of the paper

To prepare the paper Text Editor MS WORD for WINDOWS (97 – 2003) is to be used. *Font:* Times New Roman Cyr, 14 pt,-space-and-a-half. In top left-hand corner the index (UDC) should be placed. In the next line initials and authors' names, degree, academic rank are typed (type in small bold letters, centered). From the new line – paper title(capital semibold letters, centered). From the new line – abstract of the paper. Abstract – it is the summary of the paper without bibliography (headline of the summary). From the new line – Introduction. Further – the text of the paper. After the references – information about the authors: name, surname, degree, academic rank, affiliation, phone numbers for communication.

Formulas are to be typed in Equation Editor3.0 or Math-Type, using Latin or Greek symbols. Each formula is typed as one object (full-14 pt; subscript/superscript – 11pt; symbol – 120%.

Illustrations are presented as included in the text of the paper after the first reference.

Each *Table* must be printed with corresponding caption numbering.

Conclusions are typed after main part of the text.

References are arranged according to ДСТУ ГОСТ 7.1.2006 (State Standard of Ukraine), and are given as a list at the end of the manuscript. References are typed con-

secutively in the order of their citation in the text(not in alphabetic order). In the text of the manuscript references are indicated in square brackets (for instance,[1,2]).Unpublished papers can not be treated as references.

Information about authors: name, surname, middle name(full),degree ,academic rank, complete title of institutions where coauthors work, mailing address ,phone numbers and e-mail addresses.
